



Use **Rosie's Doggy Database** to find out about different breeds of dogs. Once you know how to search the database, you can use it to find out which breed of dog will make the best pet for these different people.



Mary

Mary lives by herself near the sea. She loves going for long walks on the beach. She would like a dog to keep her company. The dog would need to be big and like long walks!

He or she needs to be able to keep up with Mary and not get tired! Mary doesn't want to spend lots of time grooming a dog. One with short hair would be best.

Sally

Sally is 16. She loves running and dogs. She wants a dog that needs lots of exercise. She doesn't want a very big dog because it might pull her over. She doesn't want a little dog because she needs it to keep up with her.

She would prefer a dog with medium length hair as she thinks they are pretty.



Grandad

Grandad would like a little dog to keep him company. He walks slowly but can go quite far. He walks to the shops every day, and has a park nearby.

He is looking for a dog that needs medium length walks. His hands hurt him a lot because he is old. He needs a dog that has short hair and is easy to groom.

Dad

Dad works from home. He enjoys going for long walks in the wood near his house. He likes big dogs. Mum and the children (Andy and Kathryn) want a dog with long hair. Andy and Kathryn have promised to help groom the dog and bath him regularly.



Jamie

Jamie is eight. He has thought very carefully about the sort of dog he wants. He needs a little dog that won't be too strong for him. The dog should only need medium length walks so that mum can fit it into her day.

He would prefer a dog with medium length hair as he thinks they are pretty and their coat needs less time than long haired dogs.
