History:

- The Airedale Terrier was bred around 1850 in Yorkshire. The breed has been used around the world to hunt game.
- Since 1850 the terrier has had different names - the Working, the Waterside, and the Bingley Terrier - but it has been called the Airedale Terrier since 1879.
- During World War I Airedales were used as a reliable messenger dogs and sentries.

- Airedales are good at swimming.
- Airedales have been used for police work, as guard dogs and as guide dogs for the blind.
- The Airedale is known as the 'King of the Terriers' because of its size and strength.
